


Teacher Account Registration

Instructions for Teachers







If you are not a teacher in a school that uses our material or the school code and school name you entered during registration are wrong, your account will not have access to the online teaching resources.


If your information is correct but you don't have any access several days after you register, please send us an email at **support@binarylogic.net** with your personal details and your school information.

Add us to your Safe Senders list

To make sure that you receive the email messages you want from Binary Logic and BinaryAcademy, you should add us to your **Address Book** or your **Safe Senders** list. If your email program/service allows you to add an entire domain to the list of safe senders, add **binarylogic.net** and **binary-academy.com** domains. Otherwise, you will need to add addresses individually to the list of safe senders. Start with **ict@binarylogic.net** and **support@binarylogic.net**.








You are now logged in.

How can the teacher view the online teaching material?

For a teacher to access the Online Teaching Resources, the school must have adopted our ICT series and have a specific number of registered students per grade on the platform. The process is the following:

We create the school account on the BinaryAcademy platform, and one supervisor account and one teacher account are automatically generated and sent to the school.

1

The teacher must activate their account by logging in and providing an email, preferably under the school email domain.

2

After the email verification, the teacher will have restricted access to the teaching Resources of the first module of each grade associated with their school. This access covers the needs for the first 5-6 teaching weeks.

3

During the first days of the school year, the students in each grade must activate their online accounts. Each personal username and password are on a sticker inside their Student's Book.

All the teaching resources become available to the teacher for each grade that the number of students reaches or exceeds the minimum required activations (10 students).
